

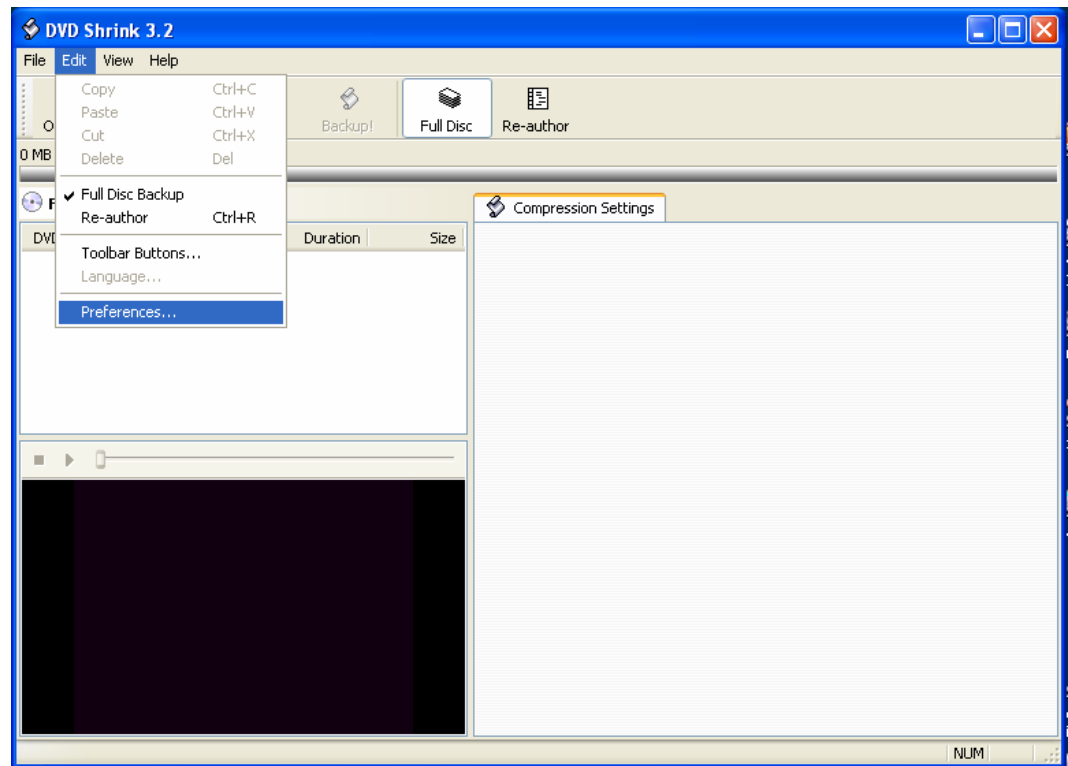
DVD Shrink – Settings

This tutorial will show you the preferred settings for DVD Shrink. We use DVD Shrink to compress the DVD movie files (which are decrypted) created in the first step using DVD Fab Decrypter. Go ahead and install DVD Shrink and it will put an Icon on your Desktop. You can now adjust the settings with the instructions below.

First you will need to start-up DVD Shrink.

Then click on **Edit** (near the top left part of the DVD Shrink window) and then click **Preferences** (at the bottom of the list of options).

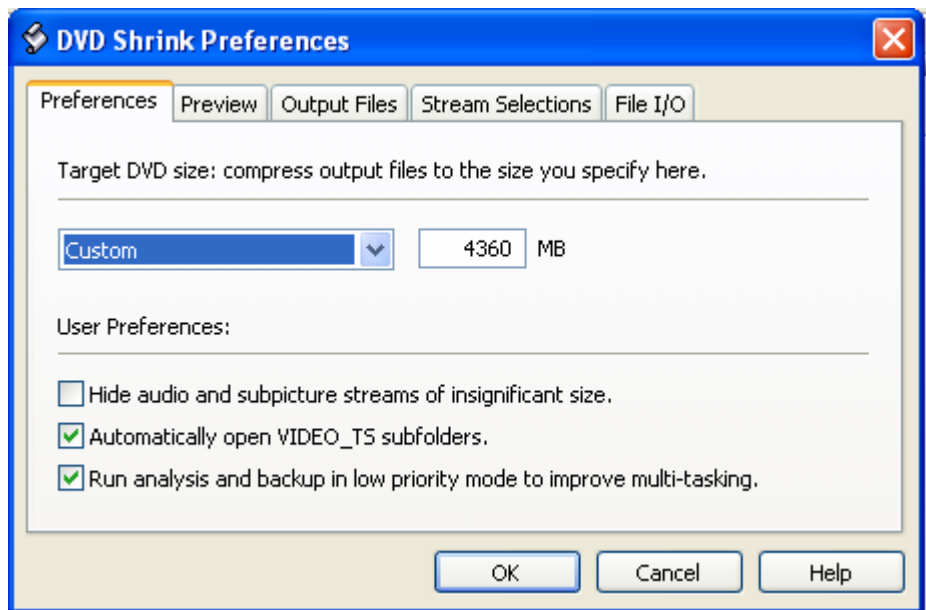
See the pic on the right to see an example of this.



You should now see a little window entitled **DVD Shrink Preferences** (like the one on the right).

In this first tab (Preferences) click the default for the DVD size is DVD-5 but we have found it best to use a custom size.

Choose **Custom** on this menu and then enter 4360 for the MB size (just like in the example on the right).

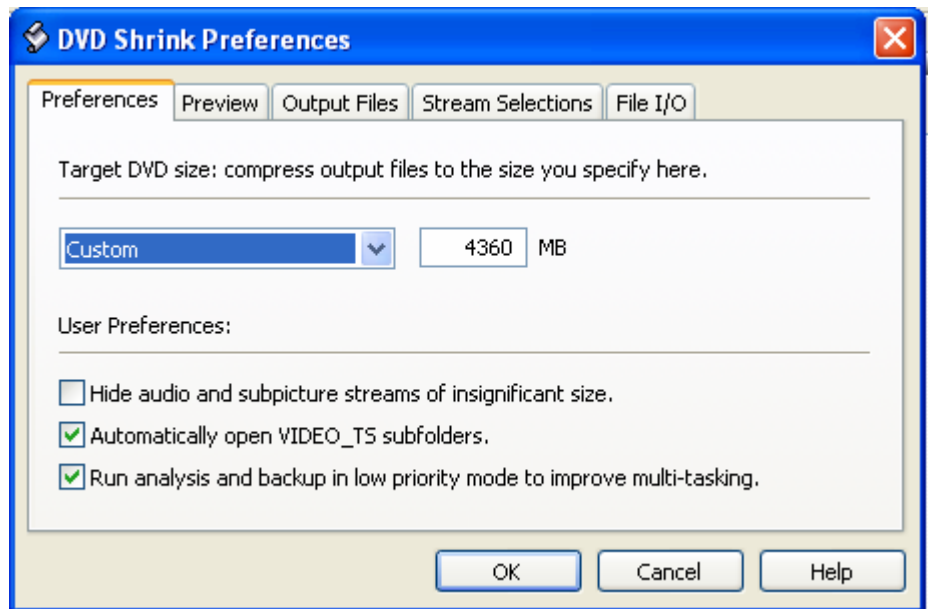

Under **User Preferences** you can choose to hide the audio and subpicture streams of insignificant size if you like. We keep them because in some movies there are areas where a foreign language is spoken and a translation is provided in text.

You want the second box checked.

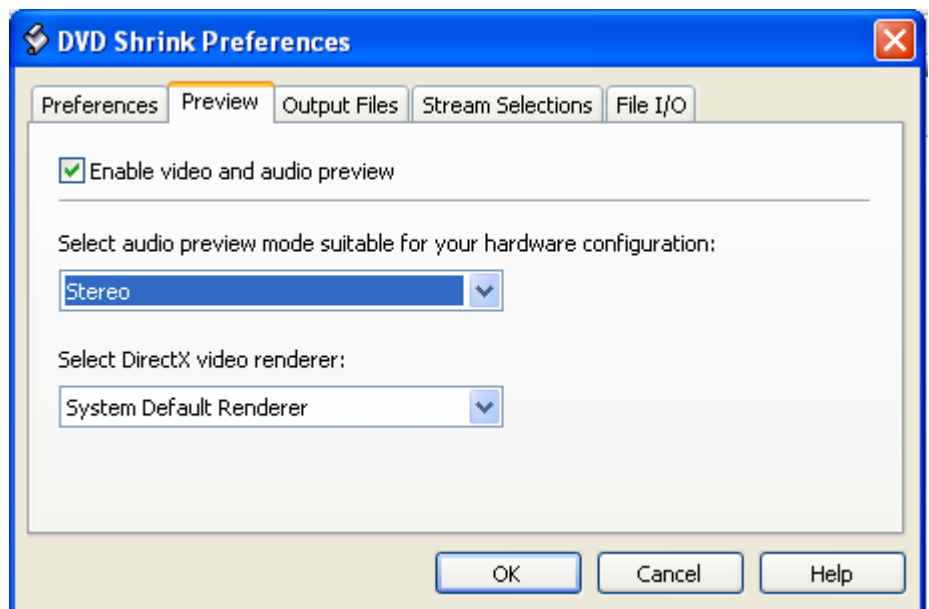
The third box tells DVD Shrink to run the analysis and backup in low priority to allow you to use your PC for other tasks. If you do not plan on using your computer while backing-up movies you can uncheck this box.



Click on the **Preview** tab and your window will look like this one.

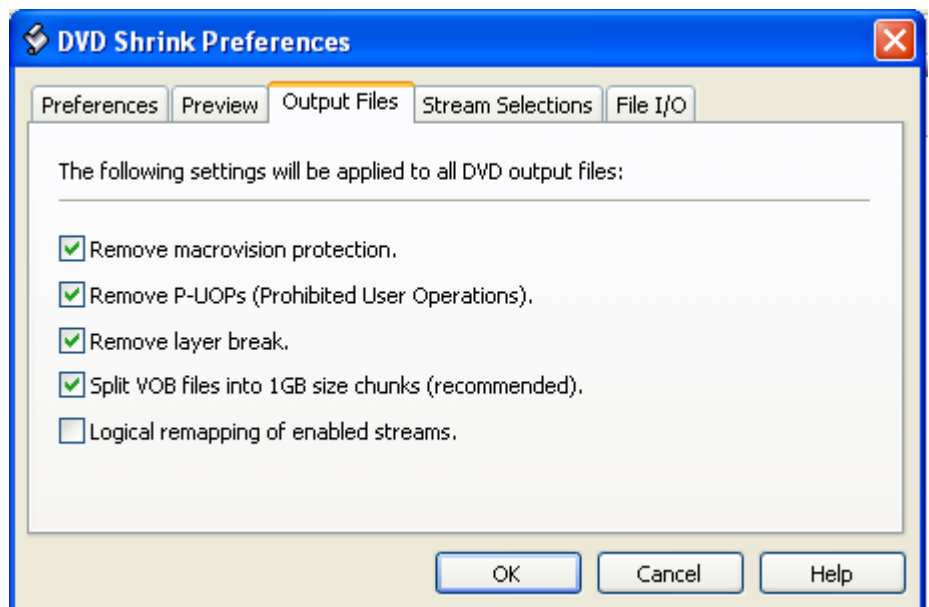
The defaults are fine on this window.

If you want surround sound for the audio preview you can choose that here.



Click on the **Output Files** tab and your window will look like this one.

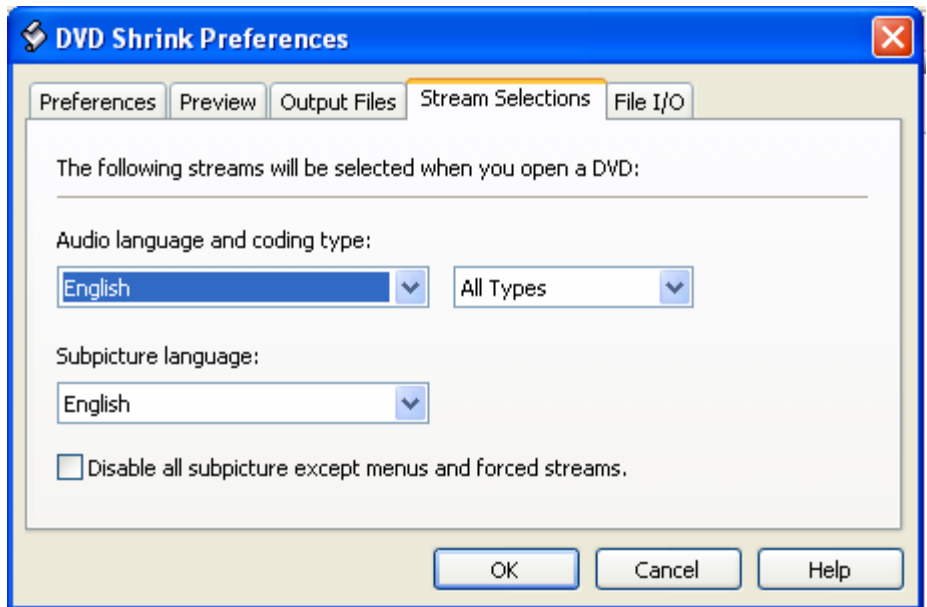
Make sure the first four boxes are checked.



Now you can click on the **Stream Selections** tab.

Here you can choose your preferred Audio language (in our case it is English).

You can also choose your **Subpicture Language** on this screen. Our preference is for English so anytime there is foreign language audio or text on the screen it will be in English).



Click on the **File I/O** tab and you will see a window like this one.

Check the third box down like in this example.

You can now click OK and this window will close.

Ok great. You are now ready to Use DVD Shrink!. You can close the program or use it to open the DVD movie files you make with DVD Fab Decrypter. (see How To Guide).
